MINIMISING DRAYTON SOUTH IMPACTS

We have moved the future Drayton South mining activities back behind the ridgeline and designed a visual bund – a vegetated hill – that will shield Drayton South’s mining operations.

We will also do the following to minimise air quality impacts:

- Spend \$125 million on dust suppression technologies;
- Progressively introduce truck models that will reduce dust;
- Surface treat all permanent haul roads with dust suppressant;
- Complete aerial seeding for rehabilitation areas; and
- Use noise suppression technology on mobile equipment.

All of this will secure the future of all industries in the Hunter Valley.
