

FOXLEIGH

Foxleigh produces premium pulverized coal injection (PCI) coal with a target rate of 3.2 million tonnes per annum (Mtpa) (100% basis).

LOCATION

- Centre of the Bowen Basin in Central Queensland, 12 kilometres south west of Middlemount;
- An open cut operation adjacent to Anglo American's Capcoal operations;
- Approximately three hours drive south west of Mackay and three hours drive north west of Rockhampton.

LEASE SIZE

- 4,965 hectares



HISTORY

- Coal production began in January 2000, less than two years after the first exploration holes were drilled;
- Anglo American purchased 70% of Foxleigh in February 2008;
- Anglo American released the draft Environmental Impact Statement Terms of Reference for Foxleigh Plains (expansion project with potential to extend Foxleigh's mine life by 15 years) in June 2010.

COAL PRODUCTION AND RESOURCES

- Producing up to 2 Mtpa of PCI coal;
- At December 2014, estimates for ROM reserves are approximately 20 Mt of PCI quality, with an additional 2.7 Mt of mineable in-situ resources outside the current mine layout.

CUSTOMERS

- Steel manufacturers in Japan, Taiwan, Korea, India and throughout Europe.
