

# Community grants program

Each year, Anglo American contributes funding to support sustainable development initiatives that make a lasting, positive contribution to the communities where we operate.

We aim to manage our mines and deliver projects in a way that ensures the benefits of mining are shared with our people, communities, local economies and stakeholders. We are proud of the longstanding relationships we have with the communities in Moranbah, Middlemount, Moura, Banana and Theodore, and are pleased to be able to support local initiatives in the community each year through our social investment and donations programs.

## Community Grants Program

Each year, Anglo American contributes funding to support sustainable development initiatives within our local areas of operation.

Requests for funding support are assessed against criteria to ensure selected initiatives deliver value, foster community development and growth, and fundamentally meet the needs of the local people in the communities we operate in.

Our Community Grant program opens **1 March 2024** and remains open for four weeks.

Additional resources will also be offered to support year-round funding for socio-economic development projects.

## Socio-Economic Development Projects

Funding for larger and more complex socio-economic development (SED) projects is available throughout the year in consultation with the Social Performance Specialist in your area.

One of the three pillars of our sustainable approach is to support the development of thriving communities in the areas where we operate. We do this by supporting projects that advance aspects of peoples livelihoods - improving health and wellbeing, employment, skills and education - and generate systemic, long term change for all stakeholders.

Organisations are invited to partner with Anglo American to develop and deliver targeted SED projects within our areas of operation in 2024 and beyond.

If your organisation is interested in delivering an SED project, you are encouraged to submit an expression of interest to your local Social Performance Specialist for consideration.



## Eligibility and criteria

### Eligibility

To receive funding, organisations must (1) have an ABN; (2) be a community organisation, not-for-profit group, or government agency, and; (3) provide services or manage sustainable community initiatives that contribute to the well-being and development of the local community.

Organisations must also be based, or operate within the footprint of one of our areas of operation, which includes Moranbah, Middlemount, Moura, Banana and Theodore.

All requested documentation must be submitted for consideration, including a completed risk assessment. A template is provided in the application form.

### Key priority areas

Successful projects will align with one or more of Anglo American's key priority areas, which are determined during our five-yearly Social Performance Planning process. This process assesses the needs of our local communities through research and community feedback, and identifies meaningful ways we can sustainably work together to address those needs.

The key priority areas identified by our Social Performance Planning process are as follows:

- Engagement
- Environment
- Health and wellbeing
- Livelihoods
